Goal 1 Key Performance Outcome College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) SY 2017-18

As documented in the District Accountability System’s Reporting, Evaluating, & Monitoring Instrument (DAS-REMI), a Key Performance Outcome for Goal I is to increase the district’s CCRPI score. The CCRPI is a comprehensive school improvement and communication platform that serves as the overarching measure of school, district, and state performance for federal and state accountability purposes. The CCRPI includes multiple indicators within the components of Content Mastery, Progress, Closing Gaps, Readiness, and Graduation Rate. Scores are reported for each of the K-5, 6-8, and 9-12 grade level bands, in addition to a single overall score.

The SY 2017-18 data represent a new baseline of performance, as the CCRPI was updated as part of Georgia’s State ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) Plan. Due to the extent of the revisions to the CCRPI calculation, SY 2017-18 scores are not comparable to prior years’ scores. A brief summary of key changes to the CCRPI calculation from SY 2016-17 to SY 2017-18 is provided below:

- Progress component now includes English Learners’ progress toward English language proficiency, as measured by ACCESS
- Progress component now weights Student Growth Percentiles by level of growth
- Achievement Gap component was eliminated (based on school’s bottom quartile – growth and performance relative to state average)
- New Closing Gaps component was added (based on school’s progress toward meeting All Students and subgroups’ performance targets)
- Readiness indicators changed (new Lexile targets and additional grade levels included; elementary and middle school ACCESS moved to Progress component; attendance measure changed; elementary and middle predictor for graduation eliminated; multiple high school measures combined into one indicator; elementary and middle Beyond the Core moved from Exceeding the Bar and qualifying middle school Beyond the Core courses added)
- Challenge Points for Subgroup Performance and Exceeding the Bar were eliminated
- Overall, component, and indicator scores reported on 100 point scale
- Component weighting changed, with Content Mastery carrying greater weight than in the prior year, while Progress carries less weight. See figure 1 for weight distribution.

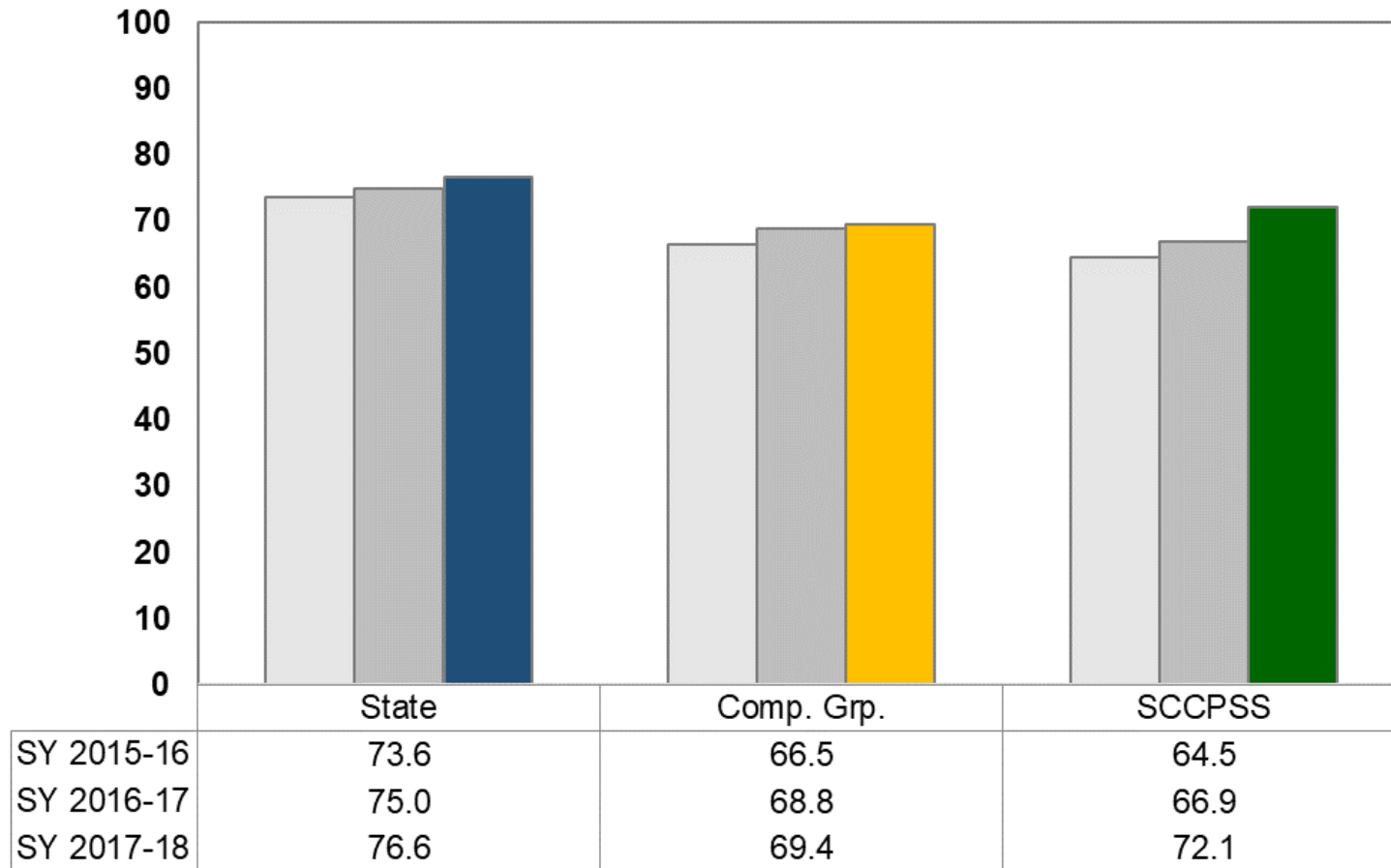
Key Points

- When SY 2017-18 CCRPI scores were publicly released, Rice Creek’s scores were incorrect due to a technical error within GADOE’s calculation. The correction of the Rice Creek school scores also impacted the district’s overall, elementary, and middle grades scores. Because Port Wentworth Elementary School’s scores rely on third grade GMAS results for former second graders, Port Wentworth’s scores were also affected by the correction to Rice Creek. All data points in this report reflect scores with the corrections made.
- The district’s Overall score was 72.1. The district performed in the top half of all districts in the state, and exceeded the comparison group of similar districts.
- The K-5 grade band earned a score of 73.5, the 6-8 grade band earned a score of 67.7, and the 9-12 grade band earned a score of 73. The district exceeded the comparison group in all grade bands, with high school performance outpacing the comparison group by more than 6 points.
- In the elementary grade band, the highest score was earned in the Closing Gaps component, at 85.5, followed closely by Progress at 82.3. The Readiness component score was 77.8, while Content Mastery was 54.2. The district exceeded the comparison group Readiness, and surpassed both the comparison group and state in Closing Gaps.
- In the middle grades, Readiness was scored highest, at 81.7, followed by Progress at 78.3; Closing Gaps at 56.9; and Content Mastery at 51.3. The district exceeded the comparison group in all components except Closing Gaps.
- In grades 9-12, Graduation Rate and Progress were the highest scored components, at 86.3 and 86.0, respectively. The Readiness score was 74.7; Closing Gaps was 72.2; and Content Mastery was 52.8. The district exceeded the comparison group in all components, and surpassed the state in Progress, Closing Gaps, Readiness, and Graduation Rate.
- School scores ranged from a low of 47.7 to a high of 97.1.
 - Overall score 90 or higher: Early College, Savannah Arts, Tybee Maritime
 - Overall score 80-89.9: Garden City, Howard, JG Smith, Woodville-Tompkins, Savannah Classical
 - Overall score 70-79.9: Brock, Marshpoint, Pooler, West Chatham Elementary, White Bluff, Ellis, Garrison, Georgetown, Godley Station, Coastal, STEM, West Chatham Middle, Islands, Johnson, New Hampstead, Oglethorpe
 - Overall score 60-69.9: AB Williams, Bloomingdale, Butler, Gould, Haven, Heard, Hodge, Largo, Port Wentworth, Pulaski, Shuman, Southwest Elementary, Windsor Forest Elementary, Hesse, Isle of Hope, Southwest Middle, Groves, Jenkins, Windsor Forest High, CEMCO, Susie King Taylor
 - Overall score 50-59.9: Gadsden, East Broad, Rice Creek, DeRenne, Hubert, Myers, Beach
 - Overall score 49.9 or lower: Low-Humanities, Mercer, the School of Liberal Studies at Savannah High

Figure 2. CCRPI Overall Score: State, Comparison Group, and District

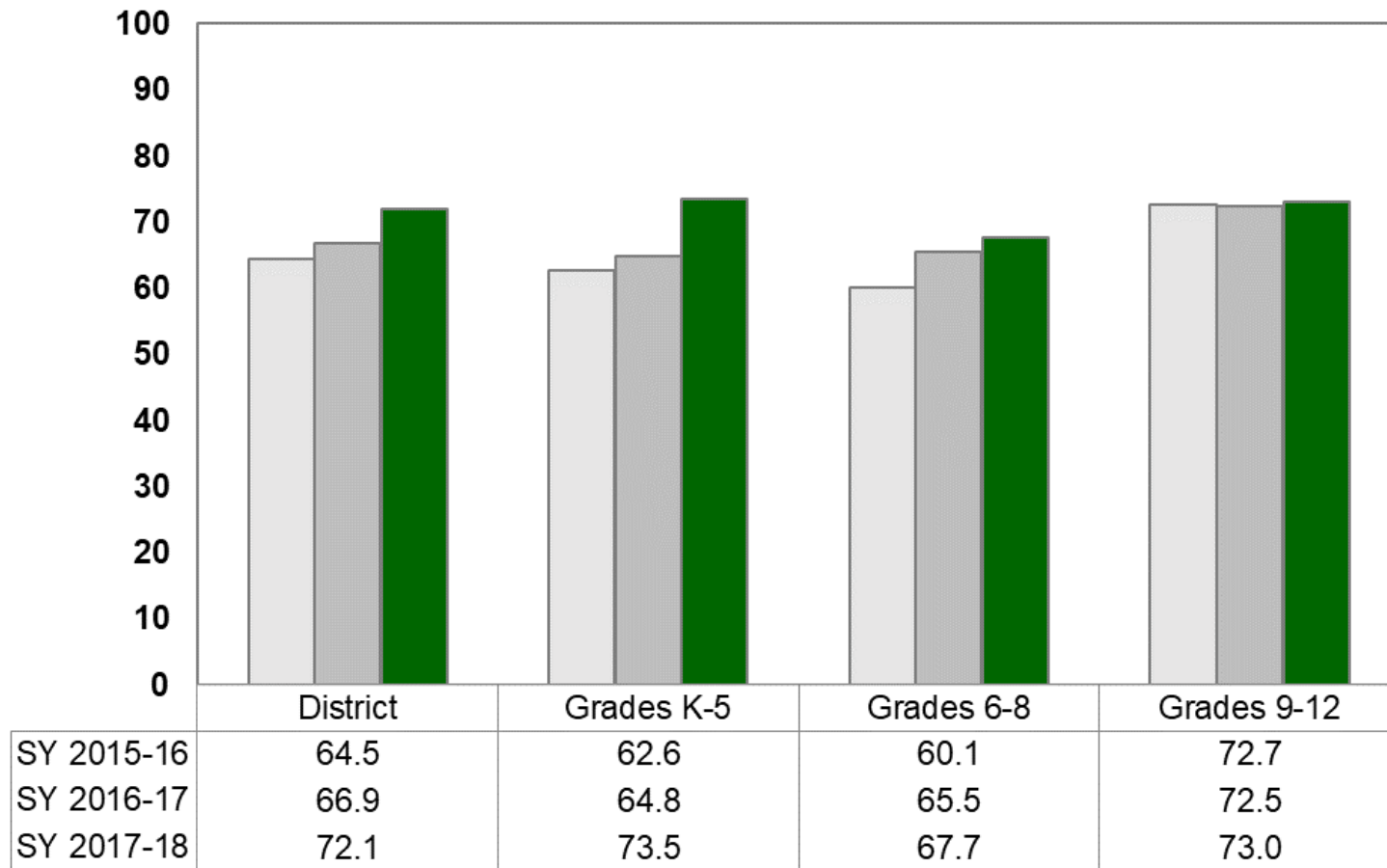

Figure 3. CCRPI Overall Score: District Summary by Grade Band

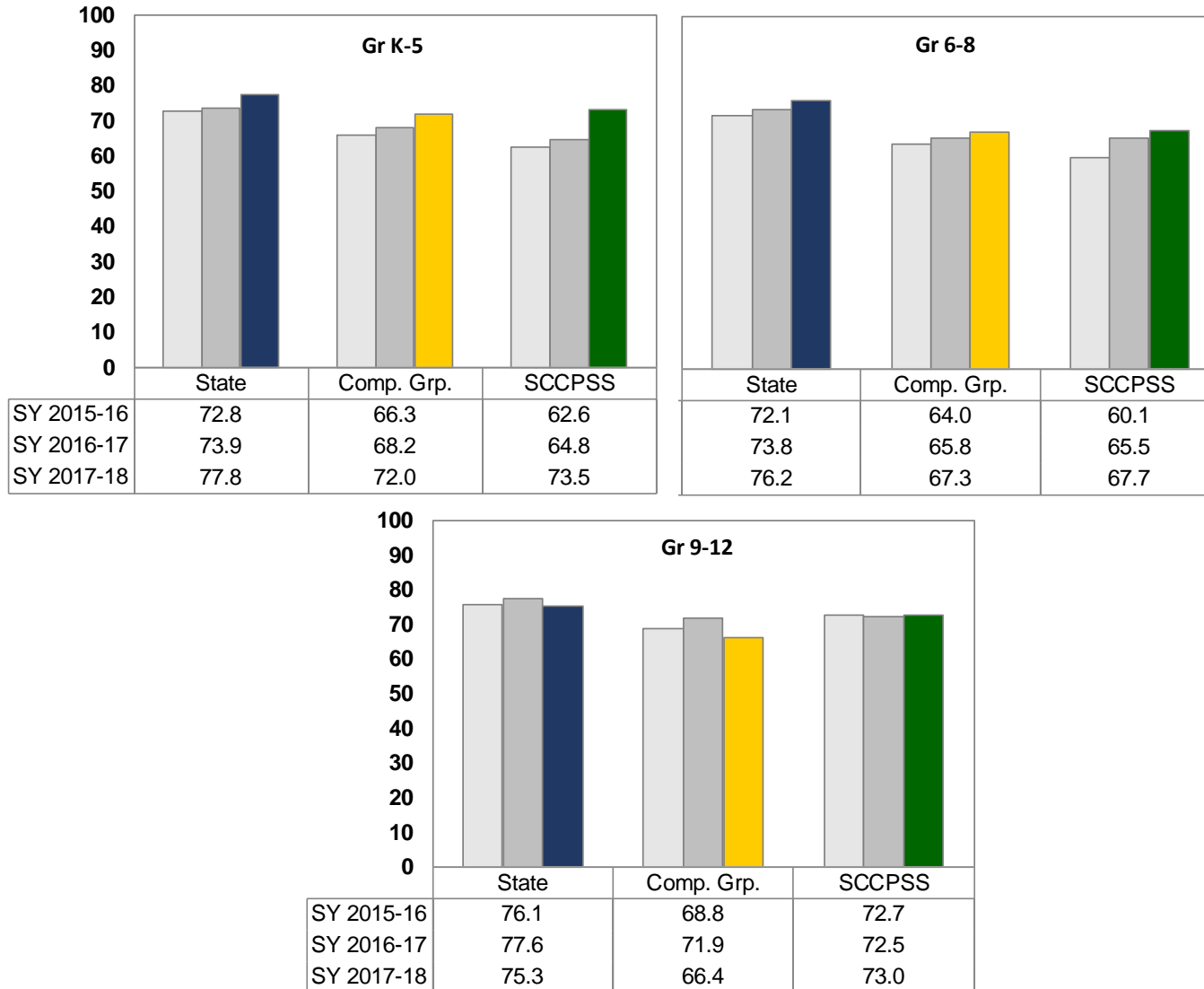
