

STUDENT FEELS SICK: COVID-19 RESPONSE PROTOCOLS

STUDENT IS AT HOME

STUDENT IS AT SCHOOL

Student remains home and any symptoms listed below are reported to principal, nurse, or designee

Student is escorted to the clinic by designee

School nurse assesses for COVID-19 symptoms in a confidential environment.
Symptoms can include: Fever (99.4 or above with contactless thermometer), Cough, Shortness of Breath, Congestion/runny nose, Loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, headache, Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, or muscle/body aches.

School nurse will determine student disposition based on assessment.

Student is escorted to the isolation space and sent home, student cannot return the next school day.

Have the symptoms improved?

Student will isolate at home. Recommend Dr. visit and/or COVID-19 testing. COVID test results must be shared with principal/designee prior to return to school

Student may return to school if they are fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications and symptoms improved.
